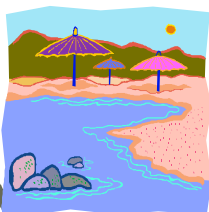

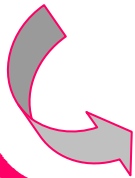

BOARD AND COMMITTEE REPORTS

BOARD REPORT—7/18/11

On July 18th chapter officers and committee chairs (both outgoing and incoming) met at Pizza Time Restaurant, with President Paula Pirozzi presiding. In Attendance were: Randee Abramson, Stephanie Cohen, Juli Evans, Kathy Gallagher, Lois Margolin, Lori Mauer, Sherri Miller, Paula Pirozzi, Beverly Provost, Dora Vilk-Shapiro, Barbara Weiss, and Fay Wilmot.

The following is a summary of the key points of the meeting:

Committee Reports:

Hospitality: Lois Margolin reported that we had 17 members and 3 guests in attendance at the Win with WIN Scavenger Hunt on July 13th at Meyer's Latin Flair Café.

Membership: Juli Evans reported 51 active members on the National Roster. She would like to see 2-3 more new members before 7/31/11. We need to maintain 50 members for Best Practices Level 1.

Newsletter: Kathy Gallagher reported that it is time to gather business card ads for the newsletter. Rates will remain the same (\$55 for 11 issues), and we may offer a mid-year rate (March – July) of \$30 for new members.

Programs: August meeting will feature Jennifer Sneedon, who will present, "Limitless Potential for Women."

Tri-County Council: Kathy Gallagher reported that the next planning meeting for Tri-County Council was Saturday July 16th at the Holiday Inn in Sarasota (following the Gulf Coast Council's "Boot Camp"). Early registration for the ABW Day Celebration, scheduled for Saturday, August 27th, 2011, is August 12th. Our chapter has budgeted funds for 10 members to attend.

Old Business:

Chapter Leadership Retreat: Incoming President Juli Evans reported that the July 9th Retreat will be held on the 3rd floor of the JM Lexus Service Center, 5350 West Sample Road in Margate. All members, especially those serving on committees are urged to attend. It is scheduled from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

Women in Distress: Stephanie Cohen reported that we collected school supplies and used cell phones at the July 13th meeting, and will continue to collect donations at the August 4th chapter meeting. She has invited a speaker from WID to attend our September meeting, for a brief introduction. Also, 9 people were scheduled to attend the Marlins vs. Mets game on Friday, July 22nd, with proceeds benefiting Women in Distress.

New Business:

We have included a budget of \$200 for a purse for the "Purse-onality" Auction at National conference. Paula suggested including a Kin-

dle. Randee agreed to coordinate the items for the purse.

President-Elect Juli Evans will give a speech to Sam's Club on August 19th at 2:00PM on Women in Leadership.

2011-2012 Chapter Year: Juli reviewed the Business Plan action items to be tracked throughout the year by the various committees. Committees that intend to hold events such as social, networking, membership, community-related activities, need to be sure they get on the master calendar.

2011-2012 Standing Rules will be updated to list all committees that will be active this year (instead of just those recognized by National). Also, request for reimbursements (for expenses as well as conferences) must be submitted within 60 days with the proper forms and receipts.

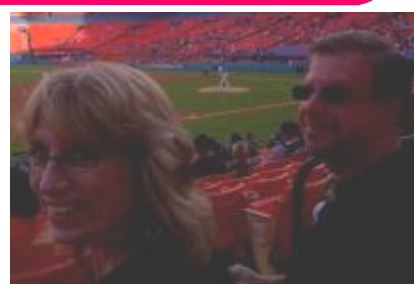
Lengthy discussion was held on the new chapter budget. Adjustments were made to reflect the \$6000 reserve from this year into next year's budget. Juli will send it out to the membership prior to the August meeting, at which time the chapter members will be asked to approve the budget, goals, and standing rules.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:00pm. The next board meeting will be on **August 15th**, at Pizza Time Restaurant beginning at 6:30pm. All members are invited to attend.

2011-2012 CHAPTER STANDING RULES (PROPOSED)

The Chapter Standing Rules will be approved by the general Membership at the August Monthly meeting. Copies of said rules will be distributed to the membership and to all new member affiliates.

Standing Rules are a list of issues that relate to our Coral Springs Chapter only. Said rules will be approved at the August Chapter meeting by a majority vote of the membership attending that meeting.

The following are the proposed standing rules for the coming year (Aug 2011 - July 2012). Said Rules will be open for discussion and accepted upon final approval by the Chapter majority vote.

PROTOCOL Standing Rules

The Chapter will adopt ABWA's Proud Code of Conduct and print this Code in each issue of the Chapter Newsletter.

The Executive Board shall consist of the following officers:

President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Past President.

In addition to those standing committees approved by National, Coral Springs Charter Chapter will recognize the following committees: Historian, Hospitality, Ladies' Night Out, Recognition, Webmaster, Technology, Chamber of Commerce Representatives, Community Relations, Tri-County Council, and Our Town Board Representatives.

The Chapter General Meeting Minutes, monthly Board Minutes, and monthly Treasurer's report are to be approved at the monthly board meetings by the executive board. The General Meeting Minutes are then published in each month's newsletter and the Treasurer's report is posted on WIN for the knowledge of the general membership.

The Chapter will be prepared to install new members no later than the 2nd monthly meeting after their application is processed by Nation-

al. The membership chairperson will install & the new member will receive her name badge and membership package.

One member will be appointed as our ABWA representative to Our Town Board and one member will serve as an alternate. Representative and Alternate will form a committee to help achieve the goal of the Our Town Board.

The criteria for awarding all scholarships will be determined locally by recommendation of the Professional Development Committee and final approval by the Executive Board.

BUDGETARY Standing Rules

Annual Chapter Dues will be \$48 per year (Pro-rated at \$4 per month for those joining in a month other than August)

Advance reservations for chapter meetings must be made by the Friday prior to the Thursday meeting. Meeting fees which include the meal will be \$32; members with advance reservations will be charged a discounted rate of \$27. Deadline for cancellations without penalty is 5:00 p.m. Sunday before the Thursday meeting. Any member that does not attend after making a reservation will be billed accordingly. All members shall be in good standing with Meeting Fees.

The Chapter will pay for the speaker's) meal's); no more than 1 per meeting without prior Executive Board Approval.

The Executive Board may approve expenditures not provided in the budget up to \$100 without the approval of the general membership.

The chapter may spend up to \$75 on gifts for outgoing presidents.

The Chapter may send cards, plants, and gifts in acknowledgment of significant life changing events for members or their imme-

diately family. Maximum of \$25 per occasion.

The Chapter will pay the Tri-County Council dues and Tamarac and Coral Springs Chambers of Commerce dues.

Any member wanting a chapter subsidy for a full registration to attend a Regional or National Conference must meet the following eligibility requirements:

be a member in good standing with dues paid, both national and local;

have attended at least 75% of the current year monthly meetings since joining the chapter;

and be serving as an active committee member or in an executive capacity.

Said representatives must attend a majority of seminars offered at the respective Conference.

For treasury record, expense receipts must accompany the Chapter Expense Reimbursement Form and be presented within 60 days following the last day of the conference. The Board will determine the amount of reimbursement based upon available budgeted funds and the number of eligible applicants. Conference fee reimbursement may not exceed total cost of the early Conference registration fee for any one member. All allotted funds NOT used for National will roll over to Regional Conference. In the event budgeted funds are available the Board, at its discretion, may consider reimbursing members for partial conference registrations.

Reimbursement for eligible members to attend Tri-County Conference in Fort Lauderdale shall not exceed \$50/person, and funds will be allocated evenly amongst all attendees after 30 days in order to determine the total number of eligible attendees. Said mem-

2011-2012 CHAPTER KEY STRATEGIES & GOALS (PROPOSED)

- I. **Strengthen Member Relationships by providing opportunities for & encouraging members to enjoy networking at coral Springs and other ABWA chapter events in the Tri-county area.**
 - a. Increase membership by attracting 20 new members & increasing the number of renewals by 1–members over the previous year.
 - b. Increase the relationship-building opportunities for members by *hosting* 1 local social, service, or networking event each quarter.
- II. **Strengthen Member Education & community Outreach by providing opportunities for & encouraging members to have fun participating in ABWA conferences & community service events.**
 - a. Increase the number of chapter members who attend local, regional and national conferences by having 5 chapter members attend 3 Quarterly Tri=County meetings, 15 members attend Tri-County conference (ABW Day) and a total of 10 members attend national and regional conferences.
 - b. Increase the community outreach opportunities for members by *participating in* 1 local social, service, or networking event each quarter.
- III. **Strengthen Chapter Leadership by providing opportunities for & encouraging members to joyfully participate in ABWA chapter committees and executive board activities.**
 - a. Increase member involvement in chapter leadership and operations by recruiting the active participation of 10 new members in committees and/or events.
 - b. Increase the member attendance at monthly general & board meetings by 10 & 5 members, respectively, over the previous year's average monthly attendance.
- IV. **Strengthen Member & ABWA Chapter Awards & Recognition by providing opportunities for & encouraging members to apply, nominate, & celebrate themselves and others.**
 - a. Increase member participation in preparation of & achievement of the Level 1 Best Practices designation awarded by ABWA National
 - b. Increase the number of member applications for Tuition Skills reimbursement through SBMEF by 2 members.

Standing Rules (Cont'd)

Members must attend the seminars offered at Tri-County Conference. All allotted funds NOT used for Tri-County will roll over to Regional or National Conference.

Members requesting tuition skills reimbursement through SBMEF must be a member in good standing both locally and at National. In order to be eligible, applicant must be a member for at least one year at the time of application, and have attended 75% of chapter meetings. Requests for reimbursement will be offered on a first come first serve basis and members will only be eligible once every two years.

All requests for chapter reimbursements must be submitted within 60 days of the expenditure and include both the receipt and completed Chapter Reimbursement Form.

MONTHLY MEETING JULY 13, 2011

The meeting began at 6:30pm at Meyer's Latin Café . Past President Dr. Dora Vilk-Shapiro called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone and self-introductions were conducted. There were 20 in attendance (17 members and 3 guests).

Chapter Business: A motion to approve the June Board Minutes was made by Barbara Weiss and seconded by Sheila Holtzman. Motion carried.

Dr. Dora Vilk-Shapiro shared information regarding our Chapter's August ABWA Meeting.

Stephanie Cohen shared information regarding Woman in Distress and the "back to school" supply drive through August. Members were asked to bring supplies to our August meeting for donation.

Lynn Fedoriw made a motion to carry over \$6000.00 from the 2010-2011 budget to support member's attendance at the national conferences. Lori Mauer seconded the motion, and the members approved unanimously.

The theme of the evening was **"Win with WIN: A Scavenger Hunt through the Women's Instructional Network."** Kathy Gallagher gave a brief introduction of WIN, and Lois Margolin gave out the instructions for the scavenger hunt . The purpose was to demonstrate the features of WIN and show members and guests how to navigate through WIN. Participants answered questions for prizes.

Joyce Hunter did individual palm readings as a courtesy to those in

attendance.


