## FROM THE PRESIDENT, PAULA PIROZZI

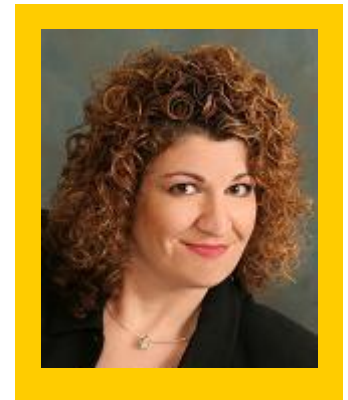

## BOARD REPORT—5/16/11

## CHRISTINA ZARRILLI 2011 SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT



Christina Zarrilli has been selected to receive this year's \$2000 Chapter Special Scholarship. Christina will be starting her junior year this fall at Florida Atlantic University's College of Engineering & Computer Science, majoring in Ocean Engineering with a minor in History. She is in the Innovation Leadership Honors Program, and as one of only a handful of women engineering majors, she reactivated FAU's chapter of the Society of Women Engineers.

Christina started going to college full time after being home schooled until age fourteen. She became interested in engineering after taking a college course titled, "Innovative Problem Solving." Since then, she has tackled a variety of projects, such as building a bridge with just spaghetti and glue, and designed and built an autonomous boat with a budget of \$5 and using recycled materials. Most recently Christina was the project leader for a homeland security endeavor that FAU did with Lockheed Martin, which resulted in expanding Lockheed's corporate support for FAU and continuing the research project.

Christina has also been enamored with NASA's space program since visiting there at age eight. Three years later she won a national science contest for her project, "Space Mashed Potatoes, Anyone?" which addressed methods for growing food in outer space. Most recently, she spent her spring break attending a week long internship at NASA.

Think Christina only has time for her studies? Think again! She is in her ninth year of service with the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) and earned the rank of Cadet Lieutenant Colonel. She serves doing disaster relief, senior citizen aid, veterans support and mentoring children. She is a founding member of FAU's Service Learning Board, started a chapter of Engineers Without Borders, volunteers with FAU's Office of Students with Disabilities, and because of her extensive volunteer and speaking experience, was selected by FAU as their TRUEBLUE Student Speaker.

Christina certainly is very intelligent and talented, and has such a bright future ahead of her. The Coral Springs Chapter of ABWA is honored to welcome Christina into our chapter as a student member. Congratulations!
